25202. PLANS FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT

A schedule detailing the applications received was tabled. Four planning applications had been received from Sheffield City Council; One was received from PDNPA.

25203. MEMBERS' REPORTS

- a) Cllr Carter reported that he had attended the Remembrance Service at High Bradfield Church and noted a distant family connection with the newly appointed Vicar.
- b) Cllr Cole raised concerns about the Sheffield Plan over potential development on Hagg Stone Road, wishing to gain clarification if this is the case.
Cllr Cole raised ongoing issues on Long Lane from soil tipping at Loxley Driving Range. Cllr Cole reported that Sheffield City Council Planning Officer Marcus Young confirmed the planning conditions on highway use are advisory only. The Clerk was asked to contact Transport, Highways, the Planning Committee, and the Sheffield Star regarding health and safety concerns.
