25115. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Cllr Barrow, Clark, Cole, Powell and Westwood-Gray.

25116. EXCLUSION OF THE PRESS AND PUBLIC

There were no items of exclusion.

25117. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST IN ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

There were no declarations of interest.

25118. PARISHIONERS' OBJECTIONS/COMMENTS

There were no items of business.

25119. CLERK'S REPORT/CORRESPONDENCE

- a) The Clerk updated Councillors on the Sewage Treatment Plant works at the Post Office, Low Bradfield, and recorded thanks to Councillor Shepherd for his assistance with the corrective works at the start of the installation.
- b) The Clerk noted an email from a local resident requesting a small family only, first birthday event in Coronation Park. Councillors had no objections.
- c) The Clerk reported an email from Councillor Cole (in his absence) highlighting concerns raised by local residents regarding the volume of delivery lorries accessing Loxley Driving Range. These concerns are to be raised with Planning Enforcement.
- d) The Clerk noted an email that was sent round earlier about an article for an idea for the cemetery and wished to know Councillors views. Councillors suggested approaching the young boy who is making the little library as to whether he could assist with this idea.

25120. DUNGWORTH CAR PARK PROPOSAL

Councillors received the budgeting costings for the works related to the proposed car park in Dungworth Park. This item to be deferred to the next Assets, Community and Environment Committee.

25121. UPPER DON TRAIL TRUST (UDTT)

Information was received from DC regarding a proposal for an information board in Coronation Park, to publicise the trail and its potential direct route from Beeley Woods to Wharnccliffe Woods. Councillors supported the proposal in principle and requested further details on the board design, specification and preferred location.

25122. NOTIFICATIONS OF DECISIONS UNDER THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT

The planning decisions made by Sheffield City Council and the Peak District National Park Authority were noted.

25123. PLANS FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT

A schedule detailing the applications received was tabled. Twelve were received from Sheffield City Council and two were from Peak District National Park Authority. Observations would be forwarded to the relevant Authority.

Plan NP/S/0325/0256 – Low Bradfield has gone to appeal; no comment was made by Bradfield Parish Council on the original application.

25124. MATTERS RELATING TO OTHER AUTHORITIES

There were no items of business.

25125. MEMBERS QUERIES AND INFORMATION

- a) Councillor Morton noted her attendance at a recent Stocksbridge and Upper Don TARA meeting and felt very welcomed and enjoyed it. Councillor Morton requested information on local notice boards and the grant policy.
- b) Councillor Baker gave an update on Stannington Pavillion.
- c) Councillor Paszek expressed frustration regarding the recent waterworks road closures and signage within the Parish, noting a lack of communication between Yorkshire Water and Amey which had resulted in disruption. The Clerk was asked to email Yorkshire Water and Amey to express Councillor Paszek's concerns.
- d) Councillors Vickers noted an email had been sent to Yorkshire Water by the office at his request regarding the chaos caused by the road closures and road works being carried out within the Parish.
