25175. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Cllrs Shepherd and Westwood-Gray

25176. EXCLUSION OF THE PRESS AND PUBLIC

There were no items of exclusion.

25177. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST IN ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

There were no declarations of interest.

25178. PARISHIONERS' OBJECTIONS/COMMENTS

There were no items of business.

25179. CLERK'S REPORT/CORRESPONDENCE

a) Following the visit from a PDNPA representative a response to the request for assistance with parking in the area has been received.

b) The Clerk informed Councillors that a message of thanks had been received from the Chair of Ecclesfield Parish Council, Cllr Susan Davidson, expressing appreciation to Cllr Tom Vickers for attending the Service of Remembrance. The event was described as a fitting tribute to those remembered at this time, and gratitude was extended to all involved.

25180. DUNGWORTH CAR PARK PROPOSAL

Councillors considered an adapted car parking plan for Dungworth Park. The Clerk undertook to obtain quotations as requested.

25181. NOTIFICATIONS OF DECISIONS UNDER THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT

The planning decisions made by Sheffield City Council and the Peak District National Park Authority were noted.

25182. PLANS FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT

A schedule detailing the applications received was tabled. Four was received from Sheffield City Council and none were from Peak District National Park Authority. Observations would be forwarded to the relevant Authority.

25183. MATTERS RELATING TO OTHER AUTHORITIES

There were no items of business.

25184. MEMBERS QUERIES AND INFORMATION

a) Cllr Carter noted the recent reduction in the speed limit on Hollins Lane and the removal of the speed camera. Residents have reported vehicles reaching speeds of up to 50mph. Cllr Baker informed Cllr Carter she would request through the LAC for the 'Smiling Sid' speed camera to be reinstated. Cllr Baker to provide Cllr Carter with contact details and information on the local Speed Awareness Group via the Police.

Cllr Carter informed Council that he was not satisfied with the wording of the Civility and Respect Pledge.

Item 25184 continued.

- b) Cllr Roberts noted her recent attendance to the STAND AGM, whereby they expressed their appreciation of funding from Bradfield Parish Council. Action for Stannington have started the task of clearing the pavilion. A petition has been implemented for a zebra crossing in Stannington.
- c) Cllr Vickers reported attending the Remembrance Sunday Service at Stannington, describing it as a lovely service and expressing pride in fellow Councillors who attended other services within the Parish.
He also noted the ongoing issue with the condition of the roads due to soil tipping on Long Lane and requested that BPC contact SCC again to express ongoing concerns.
- d) Cllr Baker reported attending the Storrs Wood Remembrance Service, describing it as a lovely service.
She noted ongoing issues with the Yorkshire Water road works.
Cllr Baker clarified that the High Riggs planning application does not exist according to Sheffield City Planning, contrary to reports in the Sheffield Star.
Positive comments have been received regarding the poppies around the Parish.
Work has commenced on Stannington Pavilion, and a petition has been started for a crossing near Church Street, Stannington.
Councillors requested further information on the Moscar Moor Asset of Community Value (ACV) application, and the Clerk was asked to obtain this.
- e) Cllr Cole reported attending the Worrall Remembrance Service, noting the attendance of the Priestley family and a local Premier League referee. He also informed Councillors of the funeral details for former Honorary Freeman, past Cllr Mike Bancroft.
- f) Cllr Powell asked fellow Councillors for any information regarding the individuals responsible for the upkeep of the Oughtibridge Estate War Memorial area. The Clerk understood the developers were to arrange future membership via site management.
