

## **MEMBERS ALLOWANCES**

Bradfield Parish Council have received a report from The Independent Parish Remuneration Panel stating their recommendations for the Scheme of Allowances payable to Councillors for 2009/10 onwards, having regard to The Local Authorities (Members' Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003 as amended and in accordance with the Regulations for 2008/09.

A copy of this report can be viewed at the Council offices between the hours of 9am – 3pm Monday to Friday.

Bradfield Parish Council, have agreed to adopt the recommendations contained within the report, as itemised below, but most Councillors forgo the payment of the allowance.

- (a) A participation allowance of £50 per annum
- (b) A basic allowance of £30 per annum available to members in recognition of costs incurred by personal information communications technology equipment and stationery in connection with Parish Council duties/business.
- (c) Travel and Subsistence allowances based on City Council Officer rates.
- (d) Availability of an annual allowance of up to £1000 (2005/06) for the Chairman of the Parish Council, index linked. Payment budgeted for currently being £530.
- (e) To forgo the entitlement to all or any part of the allowances, notice in writing should be given to the Clerk.

A record of payments made in respect of allowances paid is held in the Parish Council offices and can be viewed between the hours of 9am – 3pm Monday to Friday.
