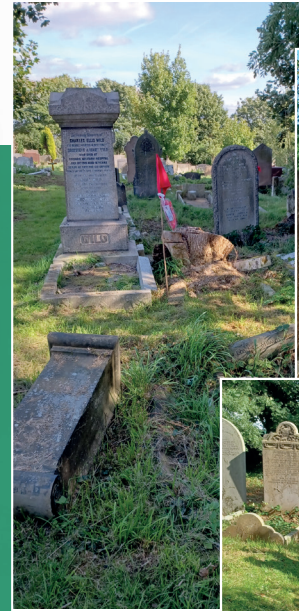
Wadsley Park
